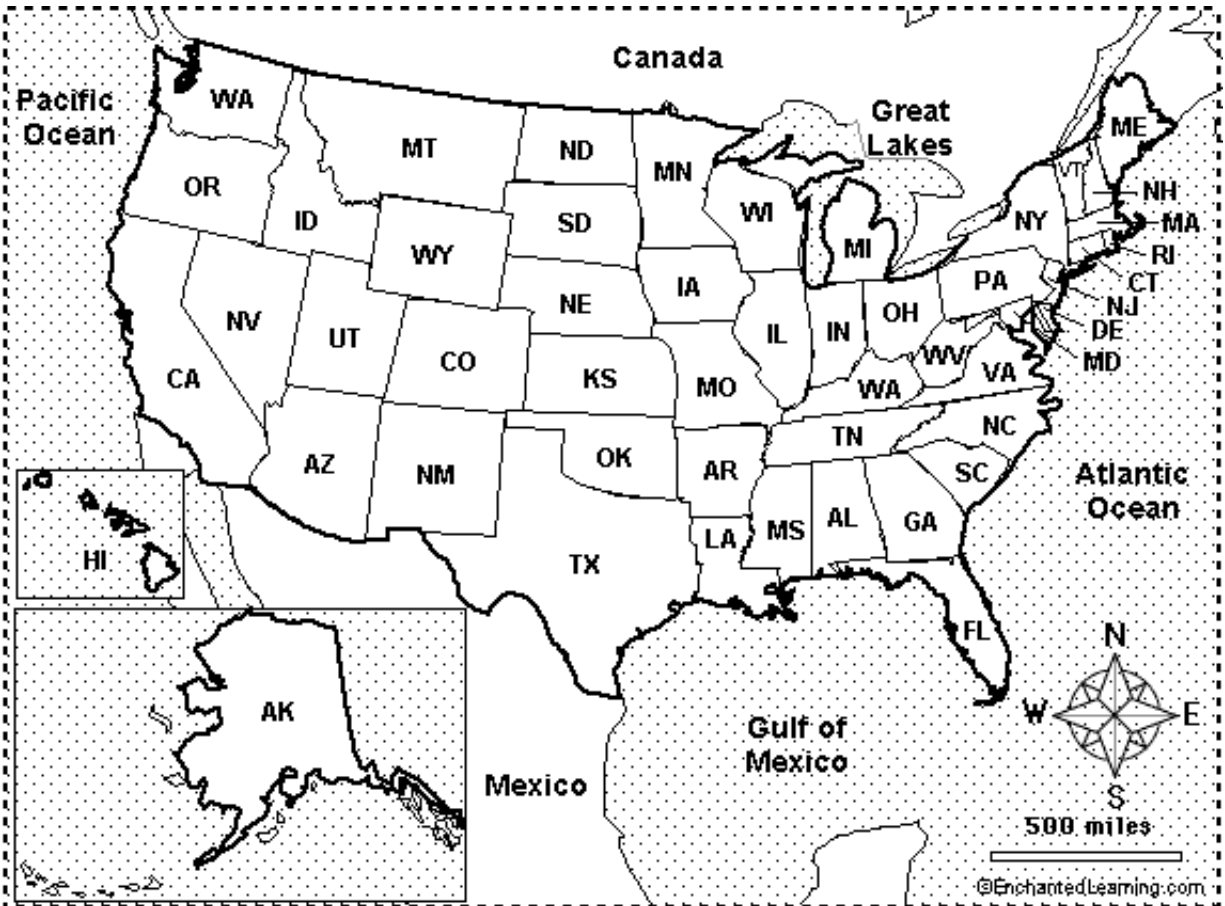
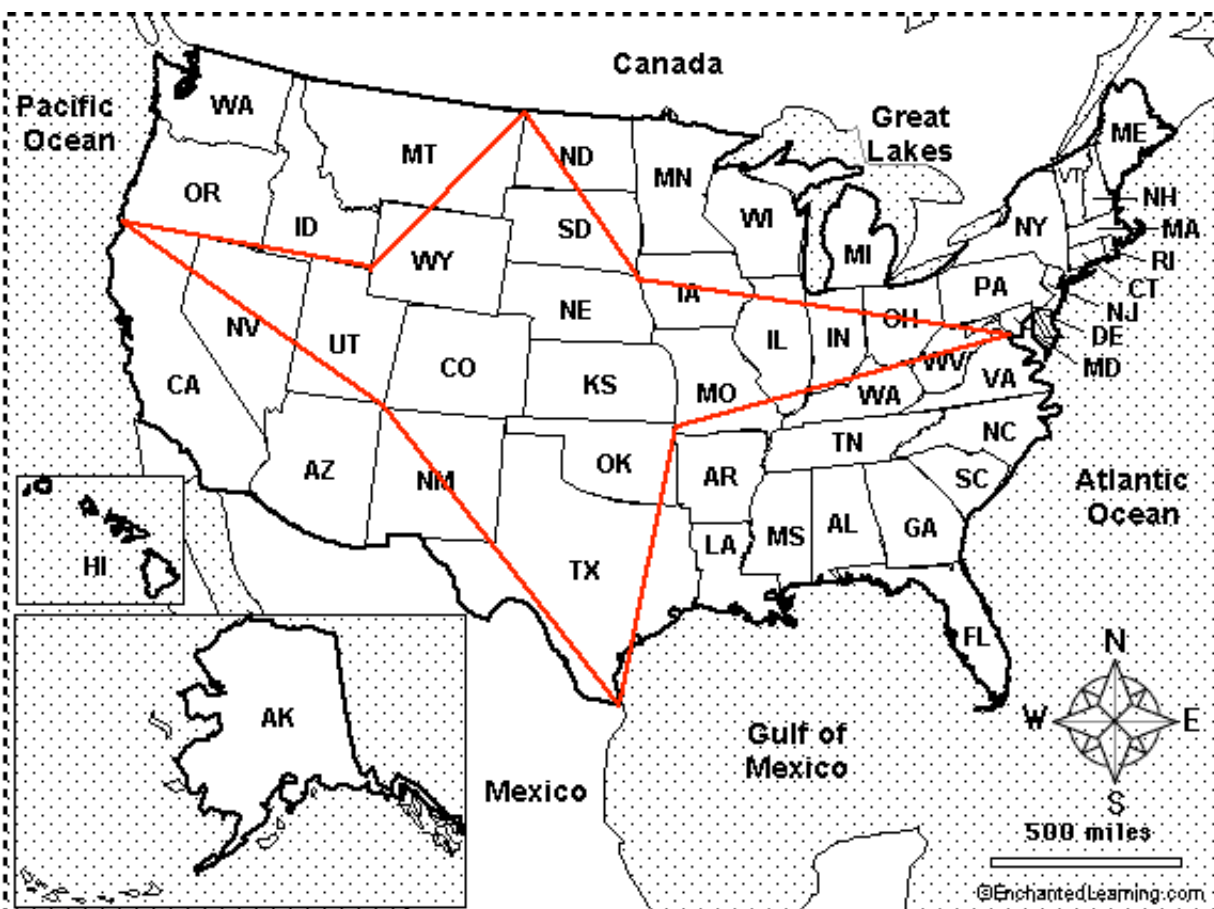


# United States of America
